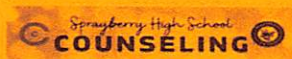

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

23.0 total units (credits) are required for all students to graduate/earn their high school diploma.

ENGLISH – 4 CREDITS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 unit of 9th Grade Literature and Composition • 1 unit of American Literature and Composition • 2 additional unit of Literature and Composition
MATH – 4 CREDITS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 unit of Algebra I or equivalent • 1 unit of Geometry or equivalent • 1 unit of Advanced Algebra or equivalent • 1 unit of a 4th Math option
SCIENCE – 4 CREDITS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 unit of Biology • 1 unit of Physics • 1 unit of either Chemistry, Earth Systems, Environmental Science, or any AP/IB Science • 1 unit of a 4th Science option
SOCIAL STUDIES – 3 CREDITS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 unit of World History • 1 unit of US History • ½ unit of Economics & Personal Finance • ½ unit of American Government
PERSONAL FITNESS AND HEALTH – 1 CREDIT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ½ unit of Personal Fitness and ½ unit of Health <p><i>NOTE: 3 units (credits) of JROTC may be used to satisfy this requirement</i></p>
WORLD LANGUAGE* and/or CAREER TECH (CTAE) and/or FINE ARTS – 3 credits
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 units from any World Language and/or CTAE and/or Fine Arts <p><i>NOTE: A minimum of 2 units from the same World Language for college-bound students*</i></p>
GENERAL ELECTIVES – 4 CREDITS
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 Additional elective credits – any subject area
<p style="text-align: center;">Students are required to take EOC exams in specified courses which count for a percentage of their overall grade. These courses include American Literature, Algebra I, Biology, and US History.</p> <p><u>NOTE:</u> Completion of the CCSD Graduation Requirements may not meet the Admission Requirements for entrance into a University System of Georgia (USG) Institution or other post-secondary institutions without additional high school coursework.</p>

Promotion to 10th grade

5.0 credits to include:

1 English, 1 Math, 1 Science

Promotion to 11th grade

10.0 credits to include:

2 English, 2 Math, 2 Science

Promotion to 12th grade

16.0 credits to include:

2 English, 2 Math, 2 Science
